January 29th: Donuts for Dads 8:30am

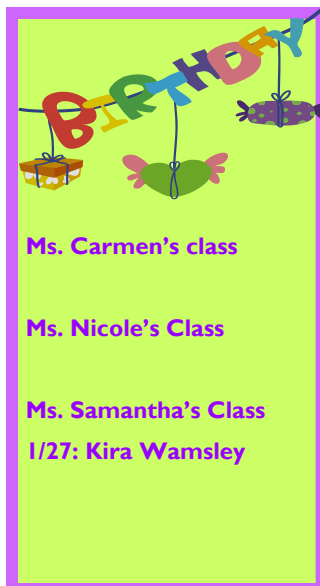
Special Note:
